

NPLQ Re-assessment Policy

Candidates on an NPLQ course may need to be re-assessed on one, two or all 3 units of the Generation 9 NPLQ if they do not successfully complete their assessments during their course.

All re-assessments taken after an NPLQ course must be sat within 28 days of the initial assessment date.

Cost:

The first reassessment is charged at £50 per candidate. The cost of this covers the assessor, pool and room hire for the duration of the assessment.

A second reassessment will be £50 + £49.50 (for the additional assessment form). A total of £99.50 per candidate.

Payment must be made in full in order to schedule the re-assessment.

Location:

All theory and practical re-assessments organised by Swim UK will take place at **Brighton Swimming Centre**.

If candidates are not able to attend Brighton Swimming Centre for a re-assessment, then they will be responsible for organising their own re-assessment at an alternative location and paying any fees associated with this – Swim UK will not be able to offer assistance in regards to this.

All assessment documents will be returned to the Swim UK office with the course box and will be dispatched to the re-assessment along with the training records of the candidate.

Assessors for re-assessments will be sourced by the Centre Contact if the re-assessment is taking place at Brighton Swimming Centre. The same assessor may be used if they have not assessed 3 assessments consecutively for that approved training centre.

Additional training is advised prior to any re-assessments taking place in the form of candidates attending staff training at their local leisure centre, attending additional hours on another NPLQ course (if available), and if possible extra time may be offered for 1:1 tuition based on operational requirements. It is the responsibility of the candidate to source this additional training after their initial course. Swim UK recommends that candidates also revise what they have learnt during the course by referring to their manuals.

Swim UK will try its utmost to provide at least an hour of additional training immediately before the NPLQ re-assessment.
